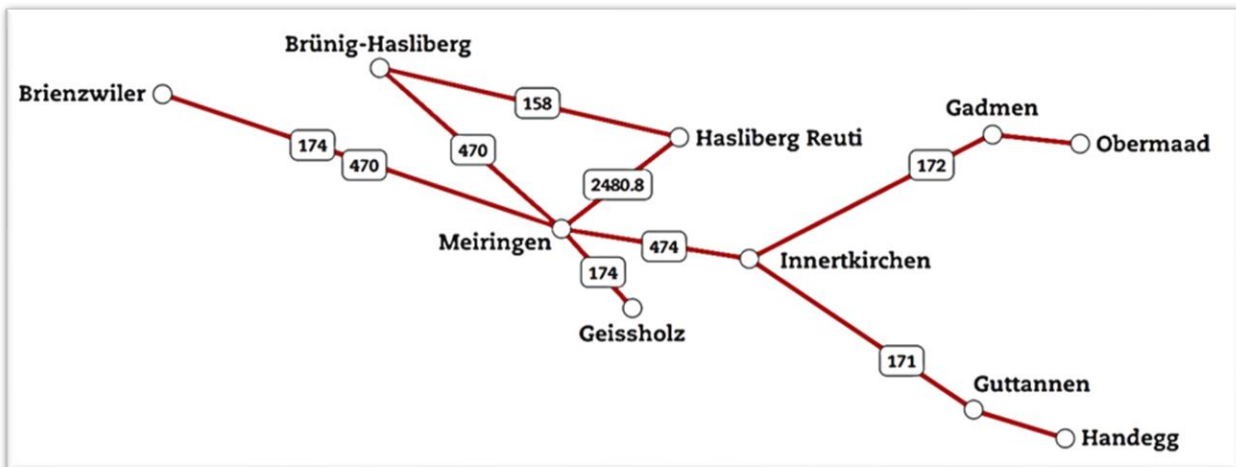

Ski region Meiringen-Hasliberg

The cable car network Meiringen-Hasliberg opens up an excursion and snow sports area between 600 and 2500 meters above sea level, allowing a panoramic view up to 401 mountain peaks.

Operating time

Cable car Meiringen – Hasliberg Reuti, operating daily according to timetable.

Regular season: Saturday, December 16th, 2023 – Monday, April 1st, 2024

All facilities in the area run daily from 8.00 am – 5.00 pm.

Operating time facilities

The facilities Hasliberg Reuti – Bidmi – Mägisalp and Hasliberg Twing – Käserstatt run daily from 8.00 am to 5.00 pm, last ascent at 4.15 pm.

The lift Mägisalp – Alpen tower runs daily from 8.30 am to 4.15 pm, last ascent at 4.00 pm.

Winter hikers benefit from attractive hiking day passes (valid only for pedestrians), which are valid within the purchased zone for an unlimited number of rides, including post bus Brünig-Reuti. With the Tourist Card Haslital you receive a 20% discount on the 3 zones hiking day pass.

Single ride tickets are also available.

The **6-day hiking pass** offers you the opportunity to use the railways as you wish on six freely selectable days during one year from the date of issue.

A wonderfully laid-out track leads along the "Gadmerwasser" on a 10 km long circular course. The imposing mountain backdrop makes cross-country skiing here a real pleasure. From the "blue" beginners' circuit to the challenging "black" circuit, there is something for everyone.

Discovering the Haslital with touring skis is one of the most beautiful way to experience the impressive nature. When planning and discovering ski tours, the current conditions and terrain should be carefully considered. We recommend booking a mountain guide. You can get suggestions on page 33.

Engstlenalp

The excellent location of Engstlenalp offers the possibility of tours on the northern slopes between "Titlis" and "Tällistock" or on the southern slopes between "Schafberg" and "Rotsandnollen".

Hasliberg

In addition to the busy slopes, there are also many hidden runs in the lower parts of the ski area which lead to the various villages on the Hasliberg and offer a bad-weather alternative.

Rosenlauri

In the north-western part of the "Reichenbach Valley" there are various tours, some of which lead through forests and over alpine pastures. On the opposite side, the "Wetterhorngruppe" offers experienced mountain hikers a large and varied area.

Sustenpass

For experienced alpinists, the Susten area is a real treat. It is possible to traverse from the Tierberglühütte via the Tierberglücke to the Windegg or Trift area and on to the Gelmerhütte.

Windegg, Gelmer

The two interconnected areas offer everything that makes alpinists' hearts beat faster. The approaches to the huts are long and are best reached from Guttannen via Mährenhorn or Furtwangsattel to Windegg or from the Aaretal to the Gelmer area.

Bächlital, Gruben

In addition to the much-frequented spring tour on the "Bächlisblatti", both valleys invite you to lonely, further marches and long descents in an alpine landscape. The "Gauli" can be reached via the "Obri Bächlilicken" or the "Ärlenlücke".

Gauli

The Gauli is a great area that allows tours on all slopes and a wide variety of terrain. The long ascent is either through the "Bächli" or "Urbachtal" valleys. As a variant, you can also access the area from "Rosenlauri" via the western "Wätterlimi" or via the "Ärlenlücke" via "Gruben".

Sledging run Käserstatt – Lischen / Mägisalp – Bidmi

The 4 km long sledging run leads from Käserstatt via Balisalp to the mid-station Lischen. On the rather flatter sections, even the younger children can enjoy in sledging themselves with bobsleds and sledges. On the 3 km long sledging run from Mägisalp to Bidmi there is nothing to get in the way of sledging fun. A speedy sledging ride pleases young and old.

The sledging runs are not closed off. Pedestrians and skiers must therefore be taken into account on individual sections of the course. For sledging, it's recommended to buy a 2 zone hiking day pass from Hasliberg or a 2+ zone hiking day pass from Meiringen.

From the mountain station of the Hasliberg Wasserwendi - Käserstatt cable car, the trail leads leisurely down to Mägisalp after a short ascent, always running along the upper forest boundary.

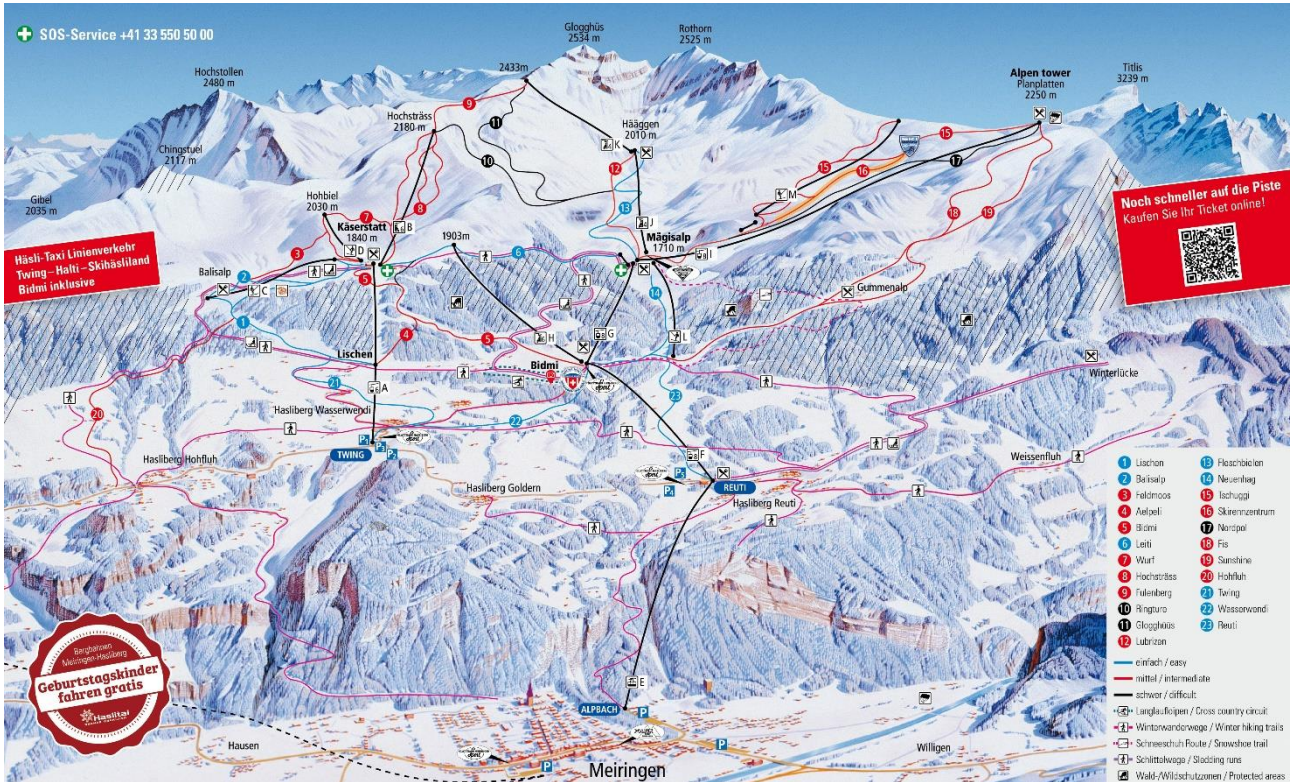

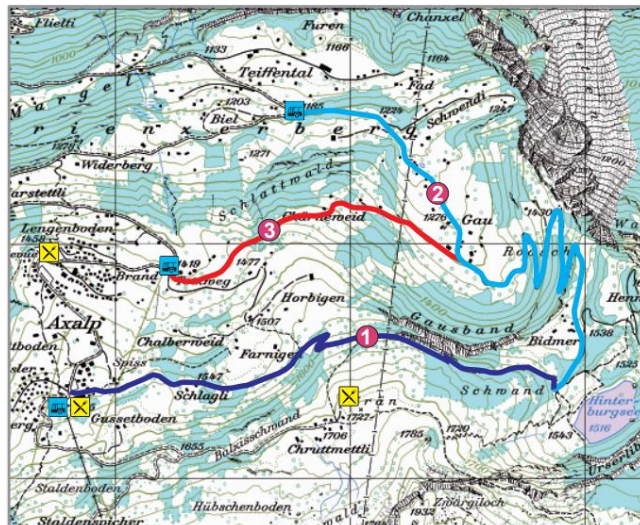

Route Sonnseite – Sand

Parking is free at the parking Lengacherli next to the carpentry Rufibach and Schläppi AG. Walk on the left side of the road towards «Gemeindehaus» and then turn at the church (right side of the road). You cross the Oberdorf, the Aare bridge and on the sun side you continue to the right. Soon you will see the sign «Wachtbühl Rundweg», follow this. Depending on the snow situation, only the short trail «Sand» is possible.

Route Sonnseite – Wachtbühl

For this a bit of a longer trail, take the same route. At the «Sand» turn-off, continue walking towards Wachtbühl where you cross the Aare via the footbridge. You return to the starting point via the snowy road.

Cross-Country Skiing Trail

The cross-country skiing trail in Guttannen is about 2 km long and starts at the “Lengacherli” car park. It is very suitable for beginners. The cross-country trail is lit until 10.00 pm. Signalisation

The winter hiking trails are signalled in bright pink and can be walked with normal hiking boots. Snowshoe routes are also marked in pink with the additional note that snowshoes are required for walking.

Before the hike

- Plan your hiking route
- Find out about the level of difficulty, distances, altitude differences and walking times using (online) maps and hiking literature
- Note the timetable times for arrival and return travel by public transport
- Check the weather forecast
- For safety reasons, inform acquaintances or relatives (host, hotel reception) about the planned tour and the approximate time of return home.
- Charge mobile phone, digital camera and GPS device
- Take enough food and drinks with you
